What do I need to have to apply to enrol my child?

- · Your child's birth certificate or identity documents.
 - · Proof of your child's residential address.
- If your child was born outside Australia or is a temporary resident of Australia, you need their passport, visa and travel documents.
- You need to tell the school whether your child has an Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) immunisation history statement.

Undescended testes

Screening for undescended testes is recommended for boys at school entry, typically around 4 to 5 years of age. Sometimes, the testes (also known as testicles) are in the scrotum at birth but may move up into the groin or abdomen at around 4-10 years of age. This happens because the cord that attaches the testis to the abdomen doesn't grow at the same rate as the child.

Undescended testes do not fully descend into the scrotum and can affect one or both testes. Parents or guardians can encourage older children to check for absence of testes in the scrotum themselves. The condition is not painful but can lead to complications such as twisting of the testis, a groin hernia, reduced fertility, and testicular cancer.

GPS continues to transition to COMPASS and families should use COMPASS to notify the school of a student's absence. Compass can be accessed at https://goomallingps-wa.compass.education/or through the COMPASS app.

To add an attendance note in COMPASS (app or browser) please follow the steps below:

From the Compass home screen click the 'Submit absence note' item accessed from the Shortcut button

On the pop-up window -select the reason from the drop-down list Enter a brief description of the absences in Details/Comment Select the start and finish date/time Click the 'Save' button.

How can I explain my child's absence?

If your child is going to be absent from school, login to your Compass account and submit an attendance note.

- 1. Click on the blue 'Shortcuts' button
- 2. Select "Submit attendance note"
- Select the child you need to add the note for
- 4. Select the Reason
- 5. Enter any Details/Comments
- 6. Select the Start/Finish Date and Time
- 7. Upload any attachments
- 8. Click on 'Add Attendance Note'
