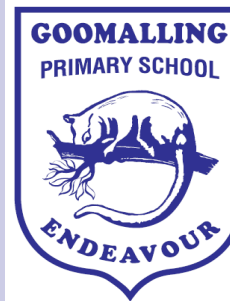

2020 Kindergarten Enrolments

Kindy enrolments are open. Please come and see us to enrol your child. Families need to apply to enrol their children in a public school for 2020 if they are:

- starting Pre-primary (first year of compulsory school) – 5 years old by 30 June 2020
- starting Year 7 (first year of secondary school)
- changing schools.

Families can also apply to enrol children in Kindergarten for 2020 if they are 4 years old by 30 June 2020.

All children from Pre-primary to Year 12 are guaranteed a place at their local public school.
