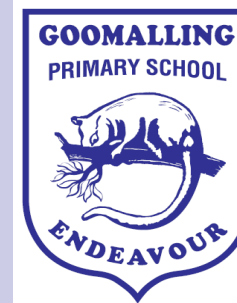

Don't forget we have early close 2.30pm every Thursday. Students on the bus will be supervised in the library from 2.30-3.00pm.

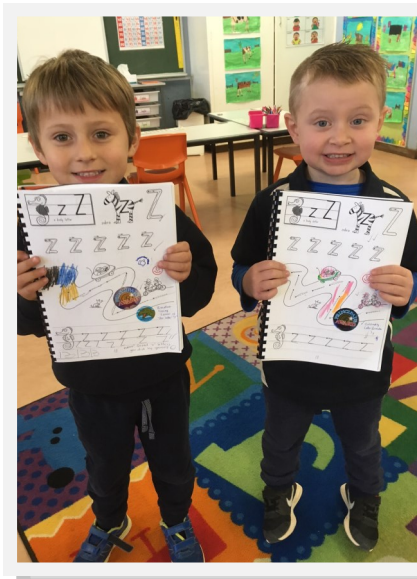
